# Rainbow poly-XFR Addendum

If you have either of the following products:

- POLY-XFR CP/M COMMS
- POLY-BSC/RJE

follow the instructions below to use the program with Version 2 of the Rainbow CP/M-86/80 operating system.

1. Make a copy of the diskette:

- Insert the Version 2.0 CP/M-86/80 diskette into drive A
- In response to the prompt, type:

```
A>DISKCOPY Return
```

- Remove the CP/M-86/80 diskette from drive A and replace it with the appropriate diskette
- Insert a blank diskette into drive B and answer the questions that DISKCOPY asks you.

When the DISKCOPY program finishes, you have a duplicate copy of the diskette.

2. Remove the original diskette from drive A, and follow the instructions on the last DISKCOPY screen to insert the CP/M-86/80 diskette.

## NOTE

Be sure you insert the working copy of the CP/M-86/80 diskette that contains the POLYPAT program.

3. After you press the Exit key, the prompt is displayed. In response to the prompt, type:

```
A>POLYPAT Return
```

Running this program makes changes to the following four files on the poly-XFR diskette:

- TRM.CMD
- XFR.CMD
- HST.CMD
- SWITCH.CMD

Running this program makes changes to the following program on the poly-BSC/RJE diskette:

- RJE.CMD
4. After these changes have been made, these diskettes are no longer compatible with Version 1 of the CP/M-86/80 operating system.
