- Page 55 section 3.4.3 "Browse Commands and Function Keys" - the list of command and function keys that are assigned a browse function also includes CMD 8: Switches between upper and lower case for entering browse commands.
- Page 24 section 3.1.2.1.1 "Operation Codes Summary" - there is a new operation code (N) for a new function which will rename library members. See tutorial topic 23 on the LIBR TUTORIAL TOPICS screen for more information.
